Dear Sir:

Please be informed that under date of November 7, 1934, this office again considered your case under recent instructions and under Public Act No. 141, 73d Congress, together with the report of your recent physical examination dated July 2, 1934.

It was determined that your nervous condition is presumptively service connected and disabling you to an extent of temporary partial 29% from June 7, 1934 (date claim for reconsideration was filed).

By reason of the aforesaid decision, you will receive payment of disability compensation on account of your presumptively service connected condition at the rate of \$21.75 per month from June 7, 1934 to January 28, 1943 (majority of first child); \$20.66 per month from January 29, 1943 to September 20, 1944 (majority of second child); and \$19.58 per month from September 21, 1944.

Upon any further change being indicated in the status of your case, you will be promptly informed with reference thereto.
