SIR (OR MADAM):

1. An act of Congress approved July 11, 1919, provides as follows:

Provided, That the act entitled 'An act to provide for the Fourteenth and subsequent decennial censuses,' approved March 3, 1919, so far as it relates to preference in employment of honorably discharged soldiers, sailors, and marines, be amended to read as follows: That hereafter in making appointments to clerical and other positions in the executive branch of the Government in the District of Columbia or elsewhere preference shall be given to honorably discharged soldiers, sailors, and marines and widows of such, and to the wives of injured soldiers, sailors, and marines who themselves are not qualified but whose wives are qualified to hold such positions." (Third Deficiency Appropriation Act, approved July 11, 1919.)

An Executive order issued by the President on March 3, 1923, provides for the following:

2. Honorably discharged soldiers, sailors, and marines and widows of such, and wives of injured soldiers, sailors, and marines who themselves are not qualified but whose wives are qualified for appointment, shall have five points added to their earned ratings in examinations for entrance to the classified service.

3. Honorably discharged soldiers, sailors, and marines who, because of disability, are entitled either to a pension by authorization of the Bureau of Pensions or to compensation or training by the Veterans' Bureau, shall have ten points added to their earned ratings in examinations for entrance to the classified service.

4. The evidence submitted by you shows that you are entitled to the preference mentioned in paragraph 3, and it has been allowed.

Retain this notice and file it with any future application for examination; otherwise it will be necessary to again submit verification of military record.
