

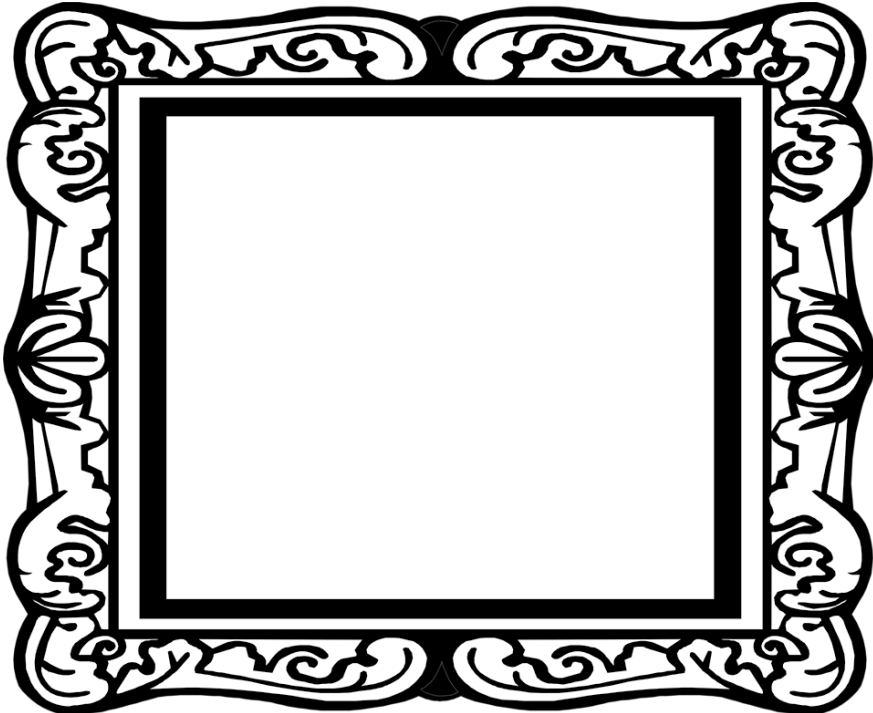

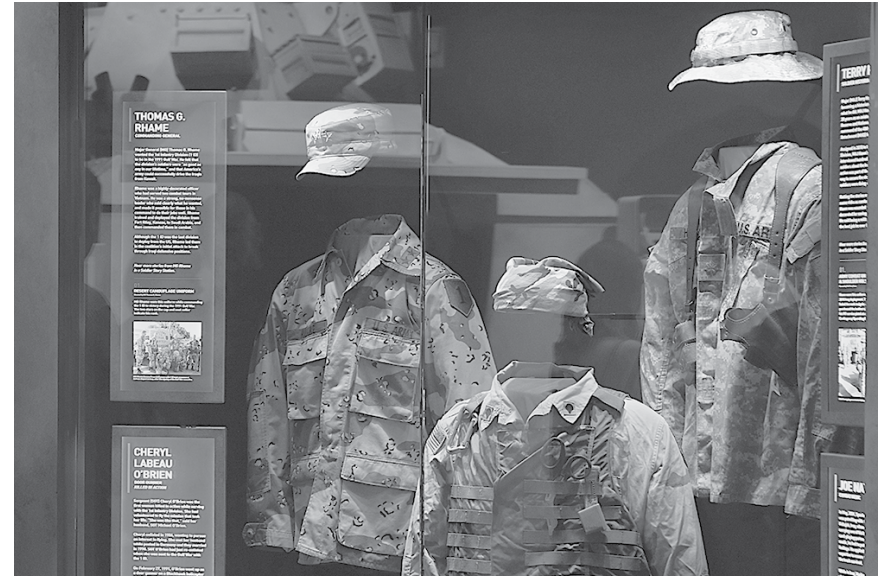
MEMORIES FROM HOME
